Once you have registered using the instructions outlined on the reverse of this letter, our Parent Portal will give you access to the following information about your young person's programme with us:

- Their four Progress Reports (more information on the reverse of this letter)
- Their attendance
- Their timetable
- Their Personal Tutor's email address

Once registered, you will be able to log in throughout the duration of their study with us simply by using your email address and password.

We hope that you find the Parent Portal a useful and convenient way of accessing information about your young person's progress throughout the year. We also have parent/guardian evenings (dates on reverse of this letter) to give you an opportunity to discuss the academic progress of your young person with their teachers. These events will be held online using specialist parent liaison event software, 'School Cloud'. We will be in touch before each event to release appointments to you and give you instructions for how to log in.

Finally, we know that the start of a new academic year is an important time for young people to start great habits to set them up for a happy and successful year. We know that parents want to support them with this. We therefore have a very early parent event, [Meet the Tutor 4.30-5.00pm Monday 18th September 2023](#), when you can meet your young person's personal tutor to hear more about the course they are studying, our expectations and support and how you can support them with their college studies at home. 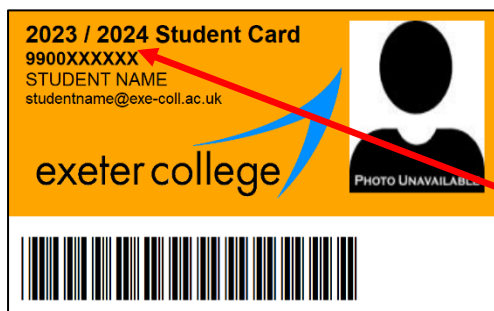

Instructions for joining our Parent Portal:

Our 'Parent Portal' can be accessed at our website by visiting parent.exe-coll.ac.uk. To register you will need first enter your details, then from your home page you will be able to link yourself to your young person(s) using the following three pieces of information:



1. The unique parent portal registration number found on this letter above
2. Your young person's date of birth
3. Your young person's student reference number at Exeter College, which can be found on their College ID card as shown here (it will start 9900)
